- It is compulsory for all learners to have the school cap at school every day and to wear it when outdoors.
- If a learner is not dressed according to uniform regulations the parent or guardian will be contacted to fetch the learner immediately and return the learner to school after the uniform irregularity has been rectified.
- A good guideline for appropriate length of culottes is 4 fingers above the knee.
- Uniforms should at all times be clean, neat and not faded or torn.
- Dates of season changes will be announced via the D6 Connect.
- **ALL items** are to be clearly marked with your child's name.

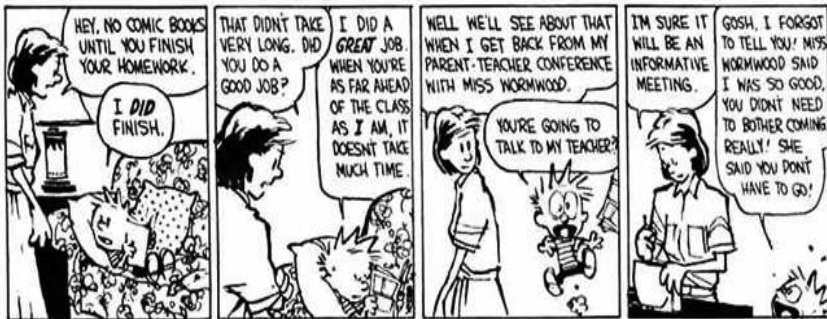

<p><b>Boys'</b> Edenglen Primary School PE shorts – navy blue Sport specific kit – if necessary, will be advised by the relevant coaches</p>	<p><b>Girls'</b> Edenglen Primary School PE shorts – navy blue <b>OR</b> Edenglen Primary School PE skirt – navy blue Sport specific kit – if necessary, will be advised by the relevant coaches</p>
<p><b>Sports Matches</b> Gr 1 to 3 – The PE uniform with the Edenglen Primary School PE golf shirt – navy with badge. Gr 4 to 7 – The PE uniform with the Edenglen Primary School PE match golf shirt – white with badge.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sport specific kit – if necessary, will be advised by the relevant coaches.</li> <li>- All jerseys and dri-macs must be removed for the matches.</li> <li>- Winter: Tracksuit pants must be removed for the match.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Interhouse Events</b> All Grades – PE uniform with Edenglen Primary School house t-shirt – house colour with badge.</p>	
<p><b>Civvies Day</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Only long denims and a suitable, tasteful t-shirt may be worn.</li> <li>- No make-up. This includes nail polish and coloured lip gloss.</li> <li>- No high heels</li> <li>- No bare midriffs or revealing clothing or torn/ripped clothing</li> <li>- No strapless tops</li> <li>- No hot pants or cut off denim shorts</li> <li>- No skirts</li> <li>- Hair is to comply with hair style guidelines</li> <li>- For water days – a plain full costume or shorts and a t-shirt, not white or see through when wet and NO bikinis.</li> <li>- Only denims and a suitable t-shirt are recommended, unless a theme day has been organised – no shorts, skirts, dungarees, cargo pants, tracksuits etc.</li> <li>- <b>Learners with 4 or more demerits may <u>not</u> wear civvies.</b> Parents will be contacted to fetch their children if this occurs, and a punishment will be issued.</li> <li>- If a learner does not adhere to the civvies dress code, a first offence will result in break detention and a demerit; a second offence will result in Friday detentions; a third offence will result in the parents being contacted to bring the correct attire and the child will be banned from participating in any more civvies days.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Hair</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Hair needs to be neat at all times.</li> <li>- Long hair is to be tied back.</li> <li>- No coloured or highlighted hair, inappropriate hairstyles or fashion styles allowed.</li> <li>- No dreadlocks, comb-overs or fades. No patterns shaved into the hair or eyebrows. No beads at the end of each braid.</li> <li>- No heavily gelled, "wet look" or obvious product use.</li> <li>- Steps should be gradually blended.</li> <li>- Hairstyles should complement the school uniform and be age appropriate, functional and easy to manage.</li> <li>- Hairstyles should not distract learners in class or when playing sport, for example by continually falling in their eyes.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Boys'</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Hair needs to be short.</li> <li>- Hair must not touch the collar, ears or eyebrows.</li> <li>- No long fringes.</li> <li>- No braids, dreadlocks, comb-overs or fades.</li> <li>- No patterns in the hair or eyebrows.</li> <li>- No coloured or highlighted hair.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Girls'</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Long hair is to be tied back with a plain navy, black or white elastic.</li> <li>- Fringes that touch the eyebrows or long strands of hair over the eyes must be clipped back.</li> <li>- Braids should be straight back or straight up only – without beads. No extensions. No single braids allowed. No coloured braids – only black.</li> <li>- Alice bands, clips, scrunchies, bands, elastics etc. to be plain navy blue, white or black.</li> <li>- No patterns in hair or eyebrows or underneath shaves covered by long hair.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Jewellery</b></p> <p><b>Boys'</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Boys are only allowed to wear wrist watches.</li> <li>- No other jewellery will be permitted (incl. Civvies days)</li> <li>- Hindu religious strings or wrist bands are allowed.</li> <li>- No piercings of any kind.</li> <li>- No tattoos of any kind.</li> <li>- No make-up allowed.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Girls'</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Appropriate wrist watches.</li> <li>- Plain gold studs or sleepers <u>only</u> – no coloured stones or other types of earrings.</li> <li>- No other jewellery will be permitted (incl. Civvies Days).</li> <li>- Hindu religious strings or wrist bands are allowed.</li> <li>- No coloured or fluffy earmuffs.</li> <li>- Only one pair of earrings permitted; no nose rings or any other piercings and no tattoos of any kind.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Make-up</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No make-up is allowed. This includes Civvies Days/Market Day and any Fun Days.</li> <li>- No coloured lip gloss, nail polish or coloured lip-ice is allowed.</li> </ul>
