LEARNER'S SPORTS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will at all times **present myself neatly**, wearing my team's sport kit with pride.
2. I will **attend all practices** as required, according to the extra-mural timetable and as required by my coach in order to improve my skills in the game.
3. I will **follow instructions given by the coach or convenor**, that are in line with the school Code of Conduct, the particular sport I am playing and the rules of the game.
4. I understand that I will not be permitted to sit with my parents at matches. I will **remain with the team** from arrival at the venue until the coach has dismissed me.
5. I will at all times **respect the decision of the coach and/or referee**. Any decisions I do not understand made by either the coach or referee, I can respectfully ask my coach to help me understand, after the match/practice and without an audience present.
6. I will follow the **lead of the captain** who will set the example for me and the rest of my teammates.
7. I will **not criticise my teammates** at practice or during matches but will always strive to encourage them to do better on the sports field.
8. I will **treat all equipment I use for the sport with respect** and will assist with the packing up of kit after practices and matches.
9. I will be **humble in victory and gracious in defeat**.
10. I will thank my coach, the referee and my opponents for a good game at the end of my match before I leave the field/court.
11. I will exercise good sportsmanship and will not heckle or interact inappropriately with the opposing team in any manner.
12. A learner may be temporarily removed from extra mural activities for the following:
 - 4 or more behavioural demerits in one term.
 - Late collection on more than 2 occasionsLearners may be added back into the extra mural programme if they show consistent good behaviour after the exclusion has been implemented.

PARENT'S SPORTS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will **show my support for my child/ren** participating in sports activities at Edenglen Primary School.
2. I will **practise self-control** in the event of decisions made by the coach or referee that I do not agree with. There is always a suitable time, place and manner in which to deal with a dispute.
3. I will **respect the decision of the referees**, regardless of whether I agree or not.
4. I will **remain seated on the stands**, away from the field of play and will not interfere with linesmen, coaches, referees or paramedics/first aiders.
5. I acknowledge that I am **not allowed onto the field/court** during play/half time/pause of play for injury.
6. I will **ensure the correct kit is worn by my child/ren** to the event they are to attend and participate in, failing which I understand my child may be excluded from the practice/match.
7. I will **not entertain or engage in arguments** with Edenglen Primary parents, parents representing opposing schools, coaches, referees or any officials at the events.
8. I will **ensure my child is with his/her team at all times** for the duration of the morning/day of the event until the coach has dismissed the players.
9. I will keep in mind **the players are children and are not professionals; it is a game, the coaches are volunteers, the referees are human.**
10. I will **not publically scold or humiliate my children** for mistakes made during play. I will at all times encourage my children and the teammates of my children to try better.
11. I **acknowledge that my failure to comply** with the above will result in verbal instruction to vacate the venue and possible instruction to temporarily no longer attend sports events related to Edenglen Primary School for a time stipulated by the school.
